# Questions/Discovery Points for Life Groups/Families

### Please read John 5:39-40

- 1. In the past, how much have you thought about Scripture being one unified story? How would you tell that story in a few minutes to someone who doesn't know the Bible at all?
- 2. How much have you thought of your life as a continuation of the story in Scripture? In a very broad sense, where does your life fit into the story?
- 3. In what ways have you seen people try to make the Bible fit their own desires?
- 4. What does it mean that humility is an integral part of saving faith, and why is this necessary?
- 5. Who is somebody you know that you would say clearly demonstrates a desire to seek Jesus? What is it about their life that demonstrates this?
- 6. What areas of your life do you tend to hold onto most tightly that may conflict with treasuring Jesus above all?
