#### I. GOSPEL AFFECTION IS THE BASIS FOR LIFE-LONG CHRISTIAN SERVICE

- John is in his 80's and still doing ministry
- Don't coast
- Look for ways to continue doing ministry
- Die doing what you love

## IV. GOSPEL PROCLAMATION IS THE CATALYST FOR CHRISTIAN HOSPITALITY (v. 5-8)

- Gaius has a reputation for his generosity and support of missions
- He does this for the sake of the gospel
- Gaius has an open door policy that welcomes strangers
- We are called to be hospitable people and use our homes for ministry

## II. GOSPEL TRUTH IS THE BASIS FOR CHRISTIAN LOVE (v. 1-2)

- We are connected in truth not merely sentiment
- We are brothers and sisters
- Philippians 1:3-11
- Does our love genuinely wish the prosperity of others? Do we pray for it?

# III. GOSPEL FAITHFULLNESS IS CAUSE FOR CHRISTIAN JOY (v. 3-4)

- Do you find joy in watching your children walk in truth?
- There is a difference between just believing truth and actually walking in it.
- 1 John 3:18
