## I. REMEMBER JESUS CHRIST

- Our first task in missions and evangelism is to be right about the gospel (Rom. 1:2-6; 1 Cor. 15:3-11; Gal 1:6-9: 2 Tim. 2:8).
- Proclaiming and defending that gospel often comes to us at a great price (2 Tim. 2:9-10; 1 Pet. 1:6-9).

#### II. WE MAY BE BOUND, BUT NEVER GOD'S WORD

- Our task is to be obedient, regardless the circumstances.
   God's task is to make his word fruitful (Isa. 55:6-11; 2 Tim. 2:9).
- God's word is living and active. It is also fixed in the heavens.
   It is moving, but it is never moved (Psalm 119:89; Heb. 4:12).
- Bible translation. Literacy. True biblical teaching. These set people free. We must endure everything so that people might hear (2 Tim. 2:10).

 $\boldsymbol{KNOW}\!:$  God's word is free. It changes people when it is opened to them.

DO: Endure all for the sake of the elect.
