THAT YOU MAY KNOW

Believe in the Son John 5:19-30 April 24, 2022

Structure of John 5:19-30:

- a. The Son reveals the Father by giving life and judgment (John 5:19-23) b. Hear the Son, and believe (John 5:24)
- a₁. The Son reveals the Father by giving life and judgment (John 5:25-30)

I. THE SON REVEALS THE FATHER (vv. 19-20, 23b, 30)

- Jesus doubles down on His claim to divinity (vv. 17-18).
- Jesus is distinct yet equal to the Father (John 1:1-2; 14:1-14; Col. 1:15-20; Heb. 1:1-3).
- Jesus does what the Father does (v. 19).

II. THE SON GIVES LIFE (v.21, 25-26, 28-29)

- Jesus grants spiritual life to the spiritually dead (Eph. 2:1-10).
- Jesus will raise the dead and give resurrection life (vv. 28-29; Rom. 8:11; Matt. 25:34-40).

III. THE SON JUDGES (vv. 22-24, 27-30)

- Jesus will save the faithful and judge the guilty (Psalm 2; Matt. 25:41-46; Rev. 19:11-21).
- Jesus is a good and righteous judge (2 Chron. 19:7; Rom. 2:11; Eph. 6:9).

IV. HEAR AND BELIEVE (v. 24a)

- Believe in the Son of God (John 3:16-17).
- Walk in the life He gives (Gal. 5:16; I John 1:7).
- Hope in the life to come (Rom. 8:18-30; Rev. 21:1-8).
